As a member of the grounds crew you will learn valuable skills as well as the experience to be a part of the day to day operations of a professionally run grounds crew. Prior experience is not required.

Minimum requirements:

Must be a current student enrolled in a two or four year degree program pursuing a degree in Sports Turf Management, or a related field.

Must be willing to temporarily relocate to Hannibal during the last week of May and stay through duration of season (approximately first week of August).

Must be able to apply internship towards college credits.

Must be an individual who is willing to work professionally along side others within the organization and adhere to organization policy and rules.

Must be willing to work long hours, and in a variety of weather conditions.

Must be a self starter.

Must be able to lift a minimum of 50 lbs.

This is an unpaid internship, however housing assistance will be provided.
