

Cavemen Host Large Upcoming Homestand

Nine games set for next eight days

HANNIBAL, MO – The Hannibal Cavemen come back home to historic Clemens Field Wednesday night after completing a season long seven day road trip. The Cavemen (6-8) are in midst of a current four game losing streak and hope to turn things around over the course of the long upcoming homestand. Hannibal holds a 3-2 record at Clemens Field this season.

The Dekalb County Liners come into town and kick off the action tonight at 6:35 PM (CT). The Danville Dans will then make their first appearance at Clemens Field this season Thursday, June 24th and will be followed by the Dupage Dragons on Friday, June 25th. Friday's game marks another round of post game fireworks courtesy of SUBWAY of Hannibal.

The Nashville Outlaws roll into town on Saturday and Sunday and will mark the only time the Outlaws will visit Clemens Field this season. With the rainout on Tuesday, June 22nd at Nashville, there remains the possibility of a doubleheader on Saturday, June 26th at Clemens Field. On Tuesday, June 29th Hannibal will host a doubleheader against the Springfield Sliders. After a rainout in Hannibal between the Sliders and Cavemen on June 7th, the two teams will begin their doubleheader on the 29th at 5:30 PM (CT). 2010 Hannibal Cavemen season ticket holders can use their June 7th ticket for admittance to both games of the doubleheader. Individual tickets sold for the June 7th game will be honored for the June 29th game and will be exchanged with the best available ticket location.

Terre Haute will conclude the homestand on Thursday, July 1st with first pitch set for 6:35 PM (CT). The Cavemen will return home a week later on July 8th to face the Springfield Sliders.
